

John Antonetti is a former Director of K-12 Curriculum. Once described as a "teacher's teacher," John is an advocate of experiential education and recognizes that all learners learn best when they work together to solve real world problems in safe, cooperative environments. Mr. Antonetti has had the great fortune to teach at all grade levels. He has taught kindergarten, elementary, middle, and high school. John has also served as supervisor of gifted programs.

John has been a lead developer and trainer in the process of classroom walk-throughs, a system for improving curriculum and instruction. He provides schools and districts with on-site instructional analysis and follow-up support through workshops, coaching, and classroom demonstration models.

Mr. Antonetti has worked with three districts that won the nationally-recognized Broad Prize for Urban Education. His work has focused on developing systemic writing programs, power standards, and district assessments. Other on-site work has included student engagement, rigor and relevance, and high-yield best practices. In addition to large urban districts, John has partnered with teachers in smaller districts to bring about improved student achievement.

His humor and parables are recognized by administrators, teachers, and parents as relevant examples of the power of teachers. Antonetti is the author of the book, *Lessons from the MIRA: Writing as a Measure of Thinking*.

Billy K. Cannaday, Jr., was appointed to a four-year term as the Superintendent of Public Instruction by Governor Timothy M. Kaine on April 12, 2006. As superintendent, Dr. Cannaday serves as the executive officer of the Virginia Department of Education. He also serves as secretary of the Board of Education. Prior to his appointment, Dr. Cannaday served as Superintendent in two of the commonwealth's largest school divisions, Chesterfield County Public Schools from 2000 to 2006 and Hampton Public Schools from 1994 - 2000. During his tenure in Chesterfield County, Dr. Cannaday was named Virginia's 2005 Superintendent of the Year by the Virginia Association of School Superintendents.

Crystal Kuykendall

Dr. Crystal Kuykendall is a critical thinker, analyst, motivator, and highly sought after speaker. She is an engaging educator, human relations expert, legal analyst/litigator, endearing author, and loving mother. Dr. Kuykendall is a former elementary and secondary public school teacher and has taught at Seton Hall University and Montclair State University. She is the former Executive Director of the National Alliance of Black School Educators and has served as Director of Urban & Minority Relations for the National School Boards Association and as the Director of the Citizens Training Institute for the National Committee for Citizens in Education. Dr. Kuykendall has served on the Advisory Board of the Education Task Force of the Congressional National Youth Leadership Conference and the Martin Luther King Jr. Center for Social Change. She was chosen by the editors of *Ebony Magazine* as one of the "**50 Leaders of the Future**" in 1979. Her publications include: Developing Leadership for Parent/Citizen Groups, Improving Black Student Achievement through Enhancing Self-Image, From Rage to Hope: Reclaiming Black and Hispanic Students, You and Yours: Making the Most of this School Year, and the second edition of From Rage to Hope. Dr. Kuykendall received her Doctorate in Educational Administration from Atlanta University and received her Juris Doctorate from Georgetown University Law Center in 1981. She was admitted to the Bar Association of the District of Columbia in 1988.
