\$1,000 or \$2,000 Grants Available for National Board Certification (NBPTS)

What? Grant monies from state and NBPTS funding will provide \$2,000 of the \$2,300 application fee to 60 teachers. In addition, a limited number of \$1,000 grants also will be available.

Candidates' Fee Responsibility:

- If selected for a \$2,000 grant, the candidate must make an initial payment of \$300 upon notification of grant selection.
- If selected for a \$1,000 grant, the candidate must make an initial payment of \$300 upon notification of grant selection. The remaining \$1,000 is due by January 31, 2002, and is paid directly to NBPTS.

Who? Virginia public school teachers may apply for a grant who meet the following criteria:

- Have a baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university;
- Have three years of teaching experience;
- Hold a valid Virginia teaching license; and
- Are employed in a Virginia school for the 2001-02 school year.

When? Grant applications are due by **May 18, 2001**; Grant notification will be mailed by **June 8, 2001**.

Selection Criteria: Grant applicants will be randomly selected and divided equally among the eight superintendents' regions.
