\* Privacy Act Statement: Unless you show proof that you receive food stamps, or TANF, Section 9 of the National School Lunch Act requires that you include the social security number of the household member signing the form or indicate that the household member signing the form does not have a social security number. You do not have to list a social security number, but if a social security number is not listed or an indication is not made that the adult household member signing the form does not have a social security number, we cannot approve the form. The social security number may be used to identify the household member in verifying the correctness of information stated on the form. This may include program reviews, audits, and investigations and may include contacting employers to determine income, contacting a food stamp, FDPIR, or, TANF office to determine current certification for food stamps, FDPIR, or TANF benefits, contacting the State employment security office to determine the amount of benefits received and checking the documentation produced by the household member to prove the amount of income received. These efforts may result in a loss or reduction of benefits, administrative claims, or legal actions if incorrect information is reported. The social security number may also be disclosed to programs as authorized under the National School Lunch Act and Child Nutrition Act, the Comptroller General of the U.S., Law enforcement officials for the purpose of investigating violations of certain Federal, State and local education, health and nutrition programs.
