## **A Narrative Summary of the PALS Screening Window for 2003-2004**

### Kindergarten

1. Fall - Screen all students to identify students needing intervention services.
2. Spring - Screen all students to identify students needing intervention services over the summer and/or in first grade.

### First Grade

1. Spring 2003 - Screen all students to identify students needing intervention services over the summer and/or in second grade. Students scoring at the "high pass benchmark" would be exempt from subsequent screenings with PALS.
2. Fall 2003 - Screen only new students to a school to determine if they need intervention services or students who received intervention services during the summer.
3. Spring 2004 - Screen all students to identify students needing intervention services over the summer and/or second grade. Students scoring at the "high pass benchmark" would be exempt from subsequent screenings with PALS.

### Second Grade

1. Fall - Screen only new students to a school to determine if they need intervention services or students who received intervention services during the summer.
2. Spring - Screen all students to identify students needing intervention services over the summer and/or in third grade. Students scoring at the "high pass benchmark" would be exempt from subsequent screenings with PALS.

### Third Grade

1. Fall - Screen only new students to a school to determine if they need intervention services or students who received intervention services during the summer.
2. Spring - Screen only those students who received intervention services during the school year.
