

From North or South I-81


Exit 143 (I-581) to Exit 5, Bear right on to Wells Avenue, Parking straight ahead.

From 220 North

220 North becomes I-581 North, Exit 4E to Route 460 (Orange Avenue), Right on Williamson Road, Right on Wells Avenue, Parking straight ahead.

From Lynchburg 460 West

460 West becomes Orange Avenue, Left on Williamson Road, Right on Wells Avenue, Parking straight ahead.
