Virginia Career and Technical Education Creating Excellence Awards Program Local Administrator's Schedule

February 2009

- ◆ Introduce Virginia Career and Technical Education Creating Excellence Awards Program to your teachers.
- ◆ Copy and give teachers the following materials:
 - Creating Excellence Awards Program Fact Sheet
 - Project Summary (Individual Teacher and Group).
- Teachers may submit an optional video clip of the project or activity. The clip should be an AVI (Audio Video Interleaved) file in an editable format on DVD or CD, not exceeding 10 minutes in length.*
- ◆ Encourage response by highlighting excellent activities already in place in your locality.
- ◆ Inform local council and school board about the Creating Excellence Awards Program; ask for their support.
- ◆ Implement Creating Excellence Awards projects in your locality.

April 15, 2009

- ◆ Collect project summaries from all teachers who participated in the Creating Excellence Awards Program.
- ◆ Order certificates for local winners from

April 15 - 30, 2009

- ◆ Set up local competition.
- ◆ Select judges. (Judges are often members of local advisory councils; they could be local business persons and community leaders. They should not be teachers or administrators from within the local school division or the Department of Education.)
- ◆ Distribute Creating Excellence Awards Program Fact Sheets and Judging Forms to panel members.
- ◆ The judges should select the following Creating Excellence Awards winners:
 - One individual teacher
 - One group
- ◆ The judges should carefully examine all entries and review them in accordance with the Creating Excellence Awards Program Fact Sheet. As noted, the most important aspect of each project should be its contribution to strengthening instruction in Career and Technical Education.

April 30, 2009

- ◆ Complete local judging.
- ◆ Recognize all participants by distributing certificates.
- ◆ For the one group and one individual project selected to move forward, complete Local Panel Statement and Career and Technical Administrator Comments and attach to the project summary.
- ◆ Forward the materials, including the optional video, on the winners in the individual and group categories (one in each category) to the Virginia Department of Education.

Individual and Group Educator Awards Fact Sheet

What is the Virginia Career and Technical Education Creating Excellence Awards Program?

- ◆ A voluntary program of recognition for all facets of Career and Technical Education in Virginia
- ◆ A program that challenges teachers to identify, initiate, and implement activities that provide exceptional classroom instruction or positive outcomes for students in Career and Technical Education
- ◆ A program that operates on three levels: local, regional, and state
- ◆ A program that has two major categories: 1) individual teacher activities and 2) collective or group activities

What are the objectives of the Creating Excellence Awards Program?

- ◆ Improvement in student achievement
- ◆ Potential for improving Career and Technical Education
- ◆ Increased reinforcement and support of the Standards of Learning
- ◆ Innovation in the classroom
- ◆ Replication or adaptation by other educators
- ◆ Increased visibility of Career and Technical Education
- ◆ Strong ties to the community and business and industry

What activities make good Creating Excellence Awards Program projects?

- ◆ Creating lesson plans and projects that enhance collaboration between core subjects and Career and Technical Education programs
- ◆ Improving student performance in the classroom
- ◆ Enhancing connections to the Standards of Learning
- ◆ Marketing Career and Technical Education to parents and students
- ◆ Expanding relationships with the business community
- ◆ Developing or expanding cooperative efforts between schools, school divisions, and community colleges
- ◆ Strengthening basic skills through the Career and Technical Education curriculum
- ◆ Targeting programs to meet the employment needs of the business community
- ◆ Using new technology in Career and Technical Education programs
- ◆ Strengthening the assessment and planning processes for Career and Technical Education
- ◆ Conceptualizing ideas that can improve any and all facets of Career and Technical Education
- ◆ Developing new teaching techniques

How does the process work?

At the local level . . .

1. Career and technical educators select an activity or an area of focus as a Creating Excellence Awards project.
2. In March, instructors complete the project summary forms and submit them to their career and technical administrator. They may include a CD or DVD of their activities.
3. A local, external panel of judges reviews all Creating Excellence Awards projects.
4. All participants are recognized for participation. One individual teacher and one group are selected and are forwarded to the Virginia Department of Education for further consideration.

At the regional level . . .

5. The regional selection process has changed. A Virginia Department of Education-selected panel of judges reviews the individual and group projects submitted by each locality.
6. The panel selects one individual teacher and one group from each region for recognition and for consideration of the state-level award.

At the state level . . .

7. The VDOE also handles the selection of the state winners from among the regional selections.
8. The individual teacher and the group of teachers cited as making the most outstanding contributions to Career and Technical Education in Virginia will be honored through a statewide awards luncheon in June.

Why do we need this program?

Excellence is the primary issue in education today. Career and technical educators should receive recognition for their exemplary contributions to this effort. The Creating Excellence Awards Program emphasizes the importance of excellence at the local, regional, and state levels while creating opportunities for teachers to enhance the quality of their programs.
