

**Certification of Tuition-Free Participation in Academic-Year Governor's Schools, Summer Residential Governor's Schools, and Governor's Foreign Language Academies

The 2010 Virginia Acts of Assembly, Chapter 874, Item 132, paragraphs C.27 a, b, d, and f.1 require the following certifications:

- That no tuition be assessed students for participation in Academic-Year Governor's School programs.
- That no tuition be assessed students for participation in Summer Residential Governor's Schools and Foreign Language Academies if they are enrolled in a public school.
- That state general fund appropriations not be used for capital outlay, structural improvements, renovations, or fixed equipment costs associated with initiation of existing or proposed Governor's Schools.
- That equal amounts of local funds have been included with state general fund appropriations for the purchase of instructional equipment for such schools.
- That, in accordance with the intent of the General Assembly, the incremental per-pupil amount be in addition to the basic aid per-pupil funding provided to the affected school division for such students. The local school divisions are encouraged to provide the appropriate portion of the basic aid per-pupil funding to the Governor's Schools for students attending these programs, adjusted for costs incurred by the school division for transportation, administration, and any portion of the day that the student does not attend a Governor's School.

Pursuant to these requirements, I hereby certify that my school division is in compliance with this language for the 2010-2011 school year.
