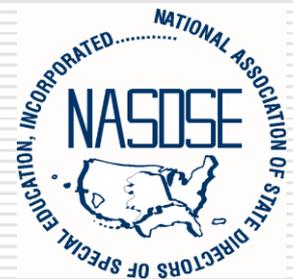


What's the Status of ESEA Reauthorization?

- Assessments



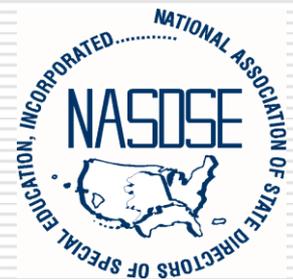
Budget/Appropriations

Common Core Standards

- ❑ State initiated from CCSSO and NGA
- ❑ Concept initially embraced by 48 states (all except Texas and Alaska – now VA governor says will not adopt)
- ❑ Covers math and reading/language arts k-12
- ❑ Impact on federal & state policy is huge

Common Core Assessments

□ Regular assessments

- Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers is a coalition of 26 states
- The SMARTER Balanced Assessment Consortium is a coalition of 31 states



Alternate Assessments

- National Center and State Collaborative Partnership (a consortium of 18 states, DC , and several territories led by the University of Minnesota). Awarded \$45 M
- The Dynamic Learning Maps Alternate Assessment System Consortium (a consortium of 11 states led by the University of Kansas). Awarded \$22 M



Autism

- Federal Interagency Coordinating Committee (IACC) – new strategic plan for research, www.iacc.hhs.gov
