



Issues Identified

- **Length of the report card: Daunting & confusing for many users**
- **Confusing data: Many users not sure what the data mean**
- **No comparison features: Comparing schools awkward & time consuming**
- **No context: Data not helpful without demographic context**

2013 Survey & Focus Groups

'Very Important' to Parents

- **Academic Results: 95%**
- **Class size: 81%**
- **Curriculum & Instruction: 75%**
- **Graduation & Dropouts: 73%**
- **Discipline & Safety: 71%**
- **Post-secondary Preparation: 63%**
- **Student Demographics: 49%**
- **Fiscal & Expenditure: 41%**

2013 Survey & Focus Groups

Report Card Recommendations

- **Tabs:** *“Would be nice to have tabs or links to more data.”*
- **Comparisons:** *“I wish the reports allow us to compare schools like CarMax allows me to compare vehicles.”*
- **Context:** *“Parents see the results & automatically assume teaching is substandard without the full picture.”*
- **User Resources:** *“Researchers would like an easily accessible data dictionary.”*






% of Classes Taught by Highly Qualified Teachers













The Career and Technical Program utilizes Project Based Learning and promotes student's participation in national programs such as FFA, BPA, TSA, and HOSA. 
