



2014-2015**





- Virginia's public school enrollment has increased by 6.32% in the last ten years.
- Hispanic student enrollment has increased by 110.24% over the last ten years representing nearly 14% of Virginia's total enrollment.
- 38 of the Nation's 100 best high schools for personal finance are in Virginia.
- Over 100,000 Board approved career and technical education credentials were earned by Virginia high school students in 2013-14 school year.
- Virginia's four year on-time graduation rates continue to climb with 90% of the 2014 cohort graduating on time.

## Student Achievement



### Students Make Across-the-Board Gains on SOLs

- Student achievement in 2014-2015 on Standards of Learning (SOL) tests in English, mathematics, history and science represents significant progress in the commonwealth's effort to better prepare students for success in college and careers.
- Statewide, students posted five-point overall gains in reading and mathematics, while achievement increased by two points each in writing, science and history.
