

PK EXPERIENCE SCENARIOS

1. Mary Catherine, a 3 year old, attends the Community Christian Daycare Center for 30 hours a week while her mother works at the nearby Food Lion. Mary Catherine goes to Rural Point Elementary School (30) in Hanover County (42) once a week to receive a 30 minute Speech Therapy session. What should Mary Catherine's record look like on the Spring SRC?

Mary Catherine would be coded PK Experience code = 30 – Coordinated Special Education, because she attends both a special education session at the school and is attending a child day care center.

2. George attends the Falling Branch Virginia Preschool Initiative Program in Montgomery County (60). It is held at Falling Branch Elementary School (600). He spends the full school day involved in many activities. How does Montgomery County report this student? George's Spring SRC record would contain the elements in the following record.

3. Sarah Lee attends a Virginia Preschool Initiative Program administered by Fairfax County Public Schools (29) held at the Seven Corners Children's Center in Falls Church which falls within the boundaries of Graham Road Elementary School (530). It is a full-day, community-based, early childhood program. Sarah qualified to participate in the program because her family lives in Fairfax County and her father works full time and her mother attends school. Their tuition is based on a sliding scale determined by the Office of Children Child Care Assistance and Referral program. How does Fairfax County (29) report Sarah Lee's record on the Spring collection?

Sarah is PK Experience code = 40, because her parents are paying a fee for her program.

4. Timothy, a 4 year old is attending Roanoke Catholic Pre-K program, a private religiously affiliated preschool program in Roanoke City (124). Timothy and his family reside within the zone for Morningside Elementary School (60). Once a week a Speech Therapist goes to Timothy's school and works with him and 3 other classmates for a 30 minute session. Roanoke City will report Timothy and his classmates as follows.

5. Peter is a 4 year old, specials needs child that lives within the boundaries of Frederick Douglas Elementary School (80) in the Winchester City Public Schools (132) division. He attends a ½ day program (3 hours) each Tuesday and Thursday at the Northwestern Regional Ed Center (284/10) for special services and programs. On Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, Peter joins the other blended PK program also held at the Regional Ed Center. How does Winchester's Spring Student Record Collection report Peter?

6. Juanita, a 4 year old, goes to Clover Land Preschool, operated by Clover Hill Baptist church in Chesterfield County (21). She attends a full day on Monday, Wednesday, and Fridays. Juanita stays with her Grandmother on Tuesdays and Thursdays each week. How is Juanita reported on the Spring SRC?

Chesterfield does not need to report Juanita because her current PK experience is not affiliated with the Division in any way.

How would Chesterfield report Juanita when she starts kindergarten in September 2007?

Juanita would be reported with a PK Experience Code = 50 – Private Provider because that was her status as of the year prior to beginning kindergarten.

7. When George was 3 years old, he went to College Park Elementary (720) in Virginia Beach (128) for a Speech Therapy class once a week. At the end of that school year, his IEP was evaluated and it was determined that Speech services were no longer needed. This school year, 2006 – 2007 he is 4 years old and is staying at home with his grandmother. How does Virginia Beach report George?

On the Spring SRC Virginia Beach does not report George because he is not currently receiving any services from the division nor does he attend any qualifying PK Experience programs.

How should George be reported on the Fall 2007 – 2008 Student Record Collection? George will turn 5 years old and become a kindergarten student in September.

George will be reported with a PK Experience Code 60 – No Formal or Institutional PK Program, because as a kindergartener you report the PK Experience Code that is applicable for the year prior to beginning kindergarten.

What if he spent that last year before starting KG ½ day with Grandma and ½ day at a Head Start Program? He should be PK Experience Code = 23 - Head Start because it is higher on the list than the code 60 – No Formal or Institutional PK Program.

8. Hannah will turn 5 years old in March 2007 and resides in Lunenburg County (55) within the attendance zone for Victoria Elementary (140). Her parents both work full time outside the home and she is cared for in the home of a neighbor. This neighbor cares for Hannah, another 4 year old girl and her own 4 year son, Kyle. At kindergarten registration during the Spring of 2007, Hannah’s mother is asked about her PK Experience during the year prior to beginning kindergarten in September 2007. Lunenburg will report the following data for Hannah on the Fall 2007 Student Record Collection.

Hannah would be reported with PK Experience Code = 51 Licensed Family Home Provider even though her Mother did not know if her neighbor was licensed by the state. This option would not apply to a parent/guardian who stayed home with their child, had a nanny, friend or relative care for the child unless there are several children being cared for. Parents in this latter situation should choose option 60 – No Formal or

Institutional PK Program. Code 51 – Licensed Family Home Provider should be chosen even though the parent/guardian may not know if their provider is licensed.

Kyle would also be reported with PK Experience Code = 51, because even though he is cared for at home, by his mother, there are several children being cared for in the private home.
