

A real picture that helps you understand what something really looks like.

The words next to or underneath a picture that explain what it is showing.

A drawing that shows the location of a place or places.

Different kinds of writing that help the reader by signaling, "Look at me! I'm important!"

A tool that is located in the back of a book. It is an alphabetical list of topics and the page numbers of where to find them in the book.

A tool that is located in the front of a book. It lists chapters and page numbers to tell where the chapters begin.

A tool that is located in the back of a book. It is a small dictionary, listing important words and their meanings.


A drawing that shows the parts of something.
