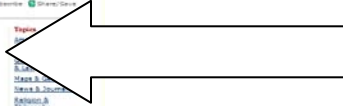
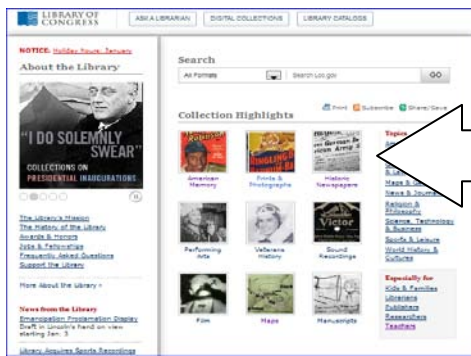


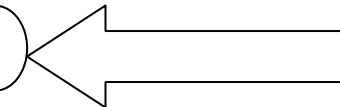
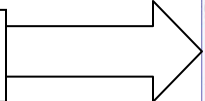
TPSNVA Guided Practice Worksheet for *Historic Newspapers*
