¹A dropout is an individual who:

- (1) Was enrolled in school at some time during the previous school year and was not enrolled on October 1 of the current school year;
- (2) Was not enrolled on October 1 of the previous school year although expected to be in membership; and
- (3) Has not graduated from high school or completed a state- or district-approved educational program; and
- (4) Does not meet any of the following exclusionary conditions:
 - (i) Transfer to another public school district, private school, or state- or district-approved education program;
 - (ii) Temporary school-recognized absence due to suspension or illness;
 - (iii) Death.

Beginning with the 2001-02 dropout reporting, the dropout rate is calculated as the number of dropouts for a given school year divided by the membership for that year.
