<sup>1</sup>Standard 1 G of the July 1, 1998 Standards of Quality states in part that licensed instructional personnel shall be assigned by each school board in a manner that produces division-wide ratios of students in average daily membership to full-time equivalent teaching positions, excluding special education teachers, principals, assistant principals, counselors, and librarians, that are not greater than the following ratios: 25 to 1 in grade KG; 24 to 1 in grade 1; 25 to 1 in grades 2-6; and 25 to 1 in English classes in grades 6-12.

<sup>2</sup>Pupil/teacher ratios for grades K-6 and grade 1 may vary from prior years because of adjustments in membership counts that include special education pupils and FTE teacher counts obtained from the 2004 Teacher Count data collection.
