Notes:

Beginning with the 2011-2012 school year a more accurate measure for calculating promotions was implemented. The new implementation fully uses Virginia's Longitudinal Data System (VLDS) by comparing a student's grade in the fall of one school year to the same student's grade in the fall of the previous school year. If the grade is higher than the previous year, the student is counted as promoted. Otherwise the student is counted as retained.

In the table above, the Number Promoted column includes all students in grades K-12 who were not in the same or lower grade the previous year. New students to the commonwealth are considered promoted. Virginia public school students who transferred between schools from one year to the next were evaluated the same as students who did not transfer. This is possible because the VLDS can match students independent of the students' school(s).
