3. Free/Reduced Price Eligibility Data is provided only for SNP Units participating in National School Lunch Program (NSLP). Some Virginia public schools (i.e., high schools) do not participate in the lunch program and therefore do not report any Free and Reduced Price Eligibility data.
4. School Division Fall Membership Report (Sep 2002) numbers do not correlate with SNP Lunch Program October 2002 Membership data.
5. School Nutrition Program (SNP) NSLP Membership and Free/Reduced Price Eligibility data reported from the SNP Electronic Claim database for Claim Month - October 2002, is used for all federal and state government eligibility data reports.
