These seminars are limited to teacher trainers who have responsibility for training educators on the integration of technology in the classroom.

Accepted applicants will be those teacher trainers employed by school districts who demonstrate their ability to embed Microsoft technologies into pedagogy, are interested and committed to engaging with the broader MIE trainer community, and who commit to training at least 100 teachers during each academic year.
