



## Getting Around the VDOE Website

The VDOE website includes a left-menu bar of top-level topics. The menu-bar, which appears on a dark blue background with white letters, features the following top-level topics:

- VDOE Home
- About VDOE — information on how the department is organized and brief descriptions of the function of each division and office including contact information
- Board of Education — information on activities and decisions of the board such as minutes of board meetings, regulations approved by the board, etc.
- News — press releases for the current year and previous five years
- For Public Education Administrators — current memos and time-sensitive and action-oriented information for division superintendents and principals as well as previous years' memos
- For Students & Parents — information frequently requested by parents and students
- Education Directories — VDOE contact information as well as school and division contacts
- Testing & Standards of Learning (SOL) — SOL curriculum frameworks, enhanced scope and sequence guides and assessment information
- Instruction — resources and information related with academic subjects taught in the classroom
- Special Education — information concerning the education of students with disabilities
- Student & School Support — information on resources, options to support the instructional environment
- Teaching in Virginia — information on requirements for teacher licensure and resources for the teaching profession
- Federal Programs — provides information related to federally funded programs to support instruction and services to specific groups of students
- Statistics & Reports — data and other statistical information and reports such as enrollment, demographics, student achievement, finances, safety and school report cards
- Information Management — information for school divisions to use in meeting reporting requirements
- School Finance — information related to financial support of Virginia's public schools

Once a user clicks on the appropriate top-level topic, the website will provide introductory information about the topic and include a right-menu bar featuring the subtopic information available to users. Links to closely related content that resides in other sections of the site (identified with a yellow background and purple letters) are listed under the heading of "You May Also Be Interested In." At the bottom of the right-menu bar, almost every page on the site includes links related to the division or office responsible for the page and staff contacts.
